Responsibility Statement

International Alumni Contacts (IACs) for the Alumni Association of the University of Michigan are volunteers who serve as a point of contact for alumni living in countries outside the United States. The Alumni Association does not generally provide alumni information and services to these individuals other than to post contact information so that other regional alumni might have a starting point should they wish to identify each other.

IACs agree that any information obtained about U-M alumni, including contact information, will be used only for alumni relations purposes and will not be sold, used for commercial interests, or shared with other interests outside the University of Michigan.

The Alumni Association provides IAC information as a service to international alumni in hopes that it will be useful to their regional interests. IACs who do not respond to inquiries to regional alumni or the Alumni Association will be withdrawn as contacts on the Alumni Association's Web site. IACs are expected to contact the Alumni Association when they no longer wish to serve in this capacity.
