

The University of Michigan Alumni Club of Greater Washington D.C. offers a \$50,000 need-based scholarship to a promising student from the Washington D.C. metropolitan region each year. The scholarship is for a student who enrolls at Michigan for the upcoming academic year.

An evaluation committee comprised of Michigan alums will review applications and select a pool of finalists for interviews. You will be contacted by April 5, 2021 if you are selected as a finalist. In-person interviews will take place on April 10, 2021 with a decision made shortly thereafter.

Applications are due Tuesday, March 23, 2021 at 11:59 PM. Completed applications should be emailed to umichdcscholarship@gmail.com by the deadline. Please type all responses in this document within the space allotted and submit your application as one PDF file. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Any student with financial need (as determined by the University of Michigan) from the D.C. metropolitan area (as defined by the University of Michigan Alumni Association) applying to the University of Michigan as an undergraduate may apply for this scholarship. You may apply for the scholarship concurrent with, or after, your application to the University, but in any case, no later than the March 23, 2021, deadline. You may apply for the scholarship without having been accepted to the University of Michigan or without having paid a deposit to attend the University of Michigan. However, enrollment to the University is a prerequisite to receiving the award.

Students applying for the UMDC Scholarship must also complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA); with a record of the FAFSA information going to the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor (Number 02325). Additionally, students must submit the College Board's CSS Profile with UM CSS code 1839. Please have your parent or guardian sign the authorization below in order for UMDC to obtain the "unmet financial need" information from the University (electronic signatures only). This information will be obtained only if you are selected as one of the finalists. Please note, you must have unmet need as determined by the University of Michigan Financial Aid Office to be eligible for the scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP DISBURSEMENT

UMDC scholarships are initially awarded for two (2) semesters (\$6,250 per semester). The balance of the scholarship shall thereafter be disbursed on a semester-basis, not to exceed six (6) additional semesters at an amount not to exceed \$6,250 per semester, provided that the awardee attends the University of Michigan and remains in good academic standing (defined as maintaining an overall grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale) and continued financial need. Disbursements shall only be made for fall and winter semesters unless coordinated and approved in advance. The eight (8) semester disbursements are available only for five (5) years after the award.
