BACKGROUND

University of Michigan Alumni Club of Charlotte (the "Club") scholarships are available to matriculating first-year undergraduate students currently enrolled full time in degree granting programs at the University of Michigan. Funding for these awards comes from earnings of the Club's endowed scholarship account. The balance of the endowed scholarship account has grown due to a combination of direct donations by alumni, students, parents, fans and friends of the University, as well as ongoing fundraising activities by the Club. It is the purpose of the Club's scholarship to reward, assist and encourage students who, if they return to the Charlotte Area after graduation, will remain active in and give back to their community.

The University of Michigan Alumni Club of Charlotte may award one or more scholarship(s) annually to a student(s) from the greater Charlotte area. Any award shall be made only for the first year of undergraduate study, paid in equal installments in the Fall and Winter semesters. Funds are distributed by the Office of Financial Aid on behalf of the Club.

BASIC APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

All applicants MUST meet the eligibility requirements listed below:

- A. Matriculation decision and enrollment deposit completed for Fall 2025 as a first-year undergraduate student;
- B. Applicant must complete and file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid, (FAFSA) or its equivalent, and have applied for and received a determination of financial need from U of M's Office of Financial Aid to be considered for the Scholarship;
- C. Applicant must have maintained a 3.0 or higher high school grade point average.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Items A-C under Basic Applicant Eligibility are minimum requirements for eligibility for the U of M Alumni Club of Charlotte scholarship. The scholarship committee will use the guidelines below when choosing among those applicants who meet the minimum requirements.

GUIDELINES FOR ALL APPLICANTS

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- 1. Complete academic transcripts of the last two years of high school undergraduate work are to be provided. Any undergraduate coursework completed prior to or concurrent with high school graduation may also be considered.
- 2. The applicant must solicit one letter of recommendation from a current academic counselor or faculty member. This letter should emphasize the student's outstanding involvement in community and school activities, or college (as applicable), and give specific examples thereof. The letter shall be sent by email to CharlotteClub@umich.edu directly from the writer by the deadline (May 31, 2025) and reference the first and last name of the applicant.
- 3. The currently enrolled University of Michigan student should submit a copy of their most recent OFA "Award Notice" with their scholarship application form, even if there is no demonstrated financial need, as the scholarship committee may consider both merit and degree of need.

- 6. **DEADLINE FOR RETURN** of all materials is **MAY 31, 2025.**
- 7. All applicants will be notified of the scholarship committee decisions by June 30, 2025, or sooner.
- 8. Applicants should understand that the award of this scholarship may have an effect on other financial assistance offered by the University of Michigan. If there are questions concerning this, the applicant is advised to contact the Office of Financial Aid at the University of Michigan.
- 9. Completed application (pages 5 7), mandatory cover page (page 4), letter of recommendation, and transcripts must be emailed no later than May 31, 2025 for consideration. All should be emailed to:
