Day 1 | Miami, Florida | Lima, Peru

Depart Miami for Lima, Peru. Upon arrival, transfer to the Pullman Lima Miraflores.

Day 2 | Lima

Highlights of Lima. View the Larco Museum's excellent collection of pottery, jewelry and artifacts that spans more than 5,000 years of pre-Columbian Peruvian history. Continue to Plaza Mayor in Lima's historic center, lined with majestic, colonial-era buildings. After lunch, see the splendid interior of the Cathedral of Lima and visit the beautiful Monastery of Santo Domingo, a religious complex with relics of important Peruvian saints. Next, tour Casa Aliaga, a delightful gem built in 1535 and still occupied by descendants of the Aliaga family. See its grand rooms richly adorned in wood and the serene courtyard.

Connects | *Meet the People.* Tonight, enjoy a Welcome Reception and Dinner at Casa Garcia Alvarado, a National Historical Building. Tour this elegant, private home and savor a traditional meal with one of the owners.

Day 3 | Lima | Iquitos | Nauta | Cruising

Transfer to Lima's airport for your flight to lquitos, the gateway to the Amazon, accessible only by plane or boat. Journey through lquitos to Nauta on the Marañon River. Along the way, see the vibrant "terra firma" (non-flooded forest) and other aspects of daily jungle life. Once in Nauta, embark the Delfin III at a private port. Admire sweeping views from the observation deck as your naturalist guide reviews your upcoming activities and the wildlife and vegetation that you are likely to see.

Day 4 | Cruising the Amazon Basin

Set out aboard skiff boats, anticipating the day's astounding and unexpected wildlife encounters. The region in which you are cruising, Pacaya Samiria National Reserve, is Peru's largest wildlife preserve, boasting more than five million acres of rich biodiversity. Skim along rivers, creeks and lagoons, where an abundance of wildlife hides in the deep rain forest, such as macaws, toucans and capybaras. Marvel at grey and pink dolphins swimming nearby. You might even glimpse the endangered charapa turtle, spider monkey or giant river otter.

Day 5 | Cruising the Amazon Basin

Never does nature seem more bountiful than in the tropics, and rising early is always rewarding since wildlife is most active at daybreak. Hike with your expert guide to discover the fantastic flora and fauna. You'll likely see brilliant parrots, hummingbirds and "laughing" falcons. Sharp eyes may spot red howler monkeys, sloths, exotic spiders, butterflies and tarantulas.

Day 6 | Nauta | Iquitos | Lima | Cusco

After breakfast, disembark the ship in Nauta and transfer via coach to the Iquitos airport.

Manatee Rescue Center. On your way to lquitos, visit this conservation center to see these gentle, endangered creatures up close. Board your flight for Cusco via Lima. Once you arrive in Cusco, take a panoramic drive to the stunning Urubamba Valley, the Sacred Valley of the Incas, amid towering mountain slopes. Check in to the Casa Andina Premium Valle Sagrado. Dine on Andean specialties tonight.

Day 7 | Sacred Valley

Sacred Valley. Explore Ollantaytambo, the ruins of an Inca fortress notable for a series of huge terraces that hug the hillside. Then, at a mountain village, learn about daily life in this challenging environment and ancient weaving methods. Enjoy a wonderful lunch afterward at a family estate that boasts gorgeous grounds, spectacular views and a collection of fine art.

Day 8 | Sacred Valley | Machu Picchu

Take in scenic views on a train ride through the Sacred Valley to the town of Aguas Calientes and the Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo hotel.

Machu Picchu. Nestled in a cloud forest high in the Andes, the Lost City of the Incas is regarded as the most important archaeological site in the Americas. The mountaintop complex contains more than 200 buildings, all of which testify to the Incas' remarkable architectural skills. Wander through the temples, palaces and grassy plazas with your expert guide.

Day 9 | Machu Picchu | Cusco

Free Time: Your morning is at leisure.

Relish lovely mountain scenery on a train ride, then depart by motor coach for Cusco and check in to the Aranwa Cusco Boutique Hotel.

Free Time: Make your own plans for dinner.

Day 10 | Cusco

Cusco, Ancient Inca Capital. Perched 11,152 feet above sea level, Cusco was the religious and administrative center of the Inca Empire. Enjoy guided visits to the Cathedral on the Plaza de Armas, noted for its colonial art, and the Santo Domingo Church, built on the foundations of the Incas' Koricancha Temple dedicated to the worship of the sun.

Take a break for a delicious lunch nearby.

Sacsayhuaman. Marvel at the huge stones (one weighs 125 tons!) of this Inca fortress constructed without any mortar.

Gather for a Farewell Reception at the hotel.

Day 11 | Cusco | Lima | Miami, Florida

Enjoy free time this morning and lunch in town. Depart for the airport and fly to Lima. Connect to your return flight to Miami, Florida. Note: Itinerary may change due to local conditions.
