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OVERVIEW

Michigania is the U-M alumni family camp owned and operated by the Alumni Association, running 11 weeks of summer camp for families each year.

More than 120 seasonal staff live on-site for the summer, making lifelong friends, learning, and engaging in impactful, challenging, and joyful work.



WHAT MAKES THIS UNLIKE OTHER CAMP JOBS?

Michigania is a family camp where families and individuals of all ages can enjoy our programs and facilities. After programming is finished for the day, staff live together in staff cabins, and campers go back to their own cabins with their families. This means staff have:

More hours off during day

Networking with adult alums

No overnight supervisory duties

Opportunity to work with all ages

Staff housing separate from campers

Community events designed just for staff

More opportunities to utilize resources offered to campers

Michigania is in Boyne City, MI, on Walloon Lake
(four hours north of Ann Arbor).



BASIC JOB INFO

Job Duties

- Teaching and facilitating educational and recreational activities for all ages
- Enforcing safety rules and guidelines for each area
- Working with a team to create an atmosphere of magic and fun

Daily Schedule

- Most staff work 8:30-11:45 a.m. and 1:15-4:45 p.m.
- Some staff work afternoons and evenings only (Teens, office, etc.)
- Staff can expect 1-2 extra duties each week outside of typical hours
- Staff work 6 days/week

Pay

- Full summer base pay: \$3,500
- Room and board included

7-8:30 p.m.: Night duty*

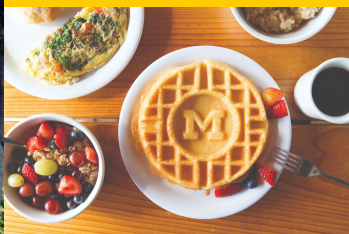
*Each staff is assigned 1-3 night duties per week. Night duties are
generally 1-2 hours long. The latest night duties end by 10 p.m. If
you aren't assigned a night duty, your work day is done at 4:45 p.m.

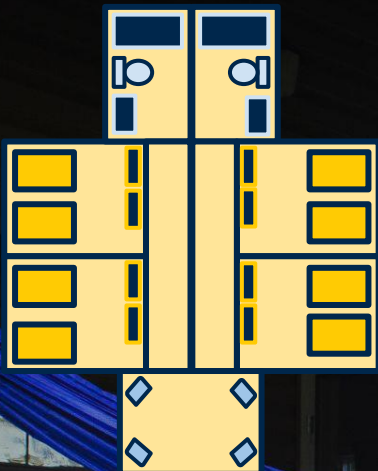

Laundry

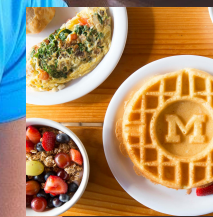
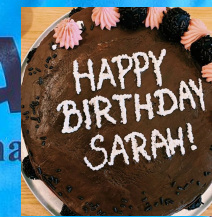
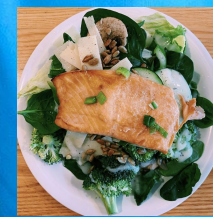


Multiple laundry locations for staff are

Staff get 3 meals daily prepared by our incredibly skilled team. Weekly menu stays the same all summer.

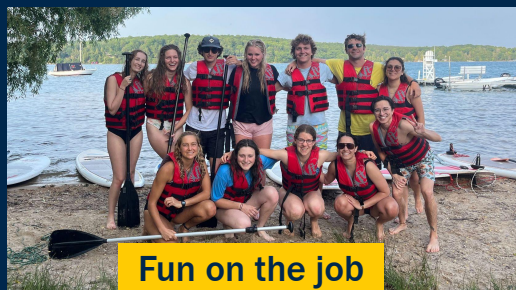
Vegetarian, vegan, & gluten free options are available at every meal.

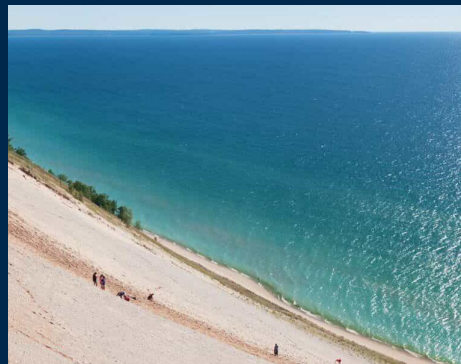

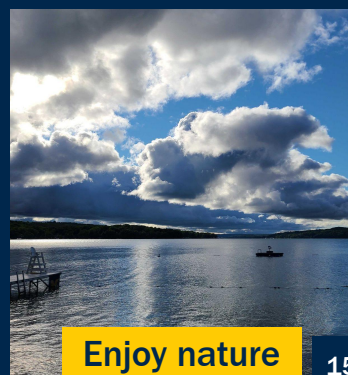

- Guests are permitted on the weekends. Guests stay with staff in their housing area.
- Additional details and process info will be shared ahead of summer.

Saturday Shifts

- A small team of staff work camper check-in on Saturdays and get a different day off during the week.
- Staff can request to work Saturdays and are selected on a rotation.
