NORDIC MAGNIFICENCE

Discovery

Rosenborg Castle. Built by King Christian IV in the early 17th century, this palace contains centuries of royal treasures, such as the three silver lions that guard the coronation chairs, as well as furnishings and portraits of monarchs from Christian IV to Frederik VII. View the treasury's sparkling jewels, including Christian IV's crown and the Anointing Sword. Wander in the castle's fragrant gardens after your guided tour.

Canals of Copenhagen. Cruise the city's scenic canals and savor lovely views from the water as you learn about Copenhagen's history. Drift past Amalienborg Palace, the royal family's home; the iconic Little Mermaid statue; the contemporary Opera House; and the distinctive Black Diamond library.

Copenhagen, Past and Present.

See the city through the eyes of its famous residents, including storyteller Hans Christian Andersen, as you meander amid charming streets and hidden squares.

Oslo. Stand at the Holmenkollen Ski Jump, the slope used in the 1952 Winter Olympics, and take in the panoramic vistas. Inside the Ski Museum on site, delve into the 4,000-year history of Nordic and downhill skiing. Finish in Vigeland Park, filled with sculptures by renowned artist Gustav Vigeland.

Nordic Seafarers. At the Viking Ship Museum, study the beautifully preserved longships up close. Head next to the Kon-Tiki Museum to see the famed vessels of Norwegian explorer Thor Heyerdahl.

Bergen Railway. Travel to Bergen on Europe's highest altitude railway and one of the most scenic routes in the world. Relish breathtaking views as you travel across the Hardangervidda, a plateau at more than 4,000 feet above sea level.

Bergen. Nestled by a harbor surrounded by seven mountains, Bergen was a major trading hub of the Hanseatic League in the late Middle Ages. Explore the merchants' warehouses in Bryggen, the old wharf. See King Haakon's Hall, Rosenkrantz Tower and St. Mary's Church. Tour the summer home of the revered composer Edvard Grieg.

The Best of Norway. Revel in some of Norway's most dazzling scenery. Take the Bergen Railway to Myrdal, then thrill to one of the world's steepest train rides on board the Flåm Railway. Snake past snow-dusted peaks and through mountain tunnels to the pristine Aurlandsfjord, a branch of the Sognefjord, Norway's longest fjord. Cruise to Gudvangen, then explore the Voss district, where vistas of mountains, forests, lakes and waterfalls await you!
