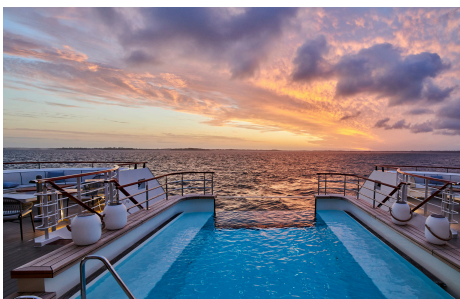

Begin with one night at The Alex Hotel Dublin, a vibrant city full of charm. A welcome reception, followed by either a half day of touring Ireland's warm cultural capital and its rich artistic and architectural heritage, or a game at the **Portmarnock Golf Club** with lunch at the clubhouse. Then, Le Lapérouse sets sails to Cobh, a charming town with cobbled streets and a 17th-century fortress, and continues to Fishguard, a quiet coastal town perfect for exploring the Welsh countryside.



Next is Warrenpoint, a seaside resort in Northern Ireland near the scenic Silent Valley Mountain Park, play **Ardglass Golf Course** where nearly every hole offers panoramic sea views. From Belfast, visit the iconic Giant's Causeway or play at **Royal County Down Golf Club**, surrounded by the Mourne Mountains. Explore Greencastle and the Inishowen Peninsula along the Wild Atlantic Way or play **Royal Portrush Golf Club**.

In Killybegs, the gateway to Donegal, you'll find dramatic cliffs, deserted beaches, and cozy pubs, or opt for a game at **Donegal Golf Club**. Sail to Oban, the capital of Argyll, with its rugged Highland coastline.

Journey to Tobermory, a charming fishing port known for its colorful houses and renowned whisky distillery, before disembarking in Glasgow. In Glasgow, enjoy **Cameron House Golf Club** or a panoramic tour and whiskey tasting, with a final night at VOCO Grand Central Glasgow Hotel.
