# AHI Connects: Dutch Delicacy.

Sample much-loved *poffertjes*, tiny, puffy pancakes topped with powdered sugar and butter, at a family-owned, small-town café.

**Frans Hals Museum.** Haarlem native Hals is regarded as one of the premier Dutch Golden Age masters, along with Rembrandt and Vermeer. With bold, loose brushstrokes, he created vivid portraits. View the largest collection of his paintings on a guided visit.

Gouda and Rotterdam. Travel into South-Holland to Gouda, famed for its namesake cheese. See the bustling market square and visit Sint Janskerk, the country's longest church. Inside, be awed by more than 70 of the finest, 16th-century painted glass windows in Europe. Afterward, taste fresh Gouda cheese and learn how it's made. Head next to Rotterdam, brimming with bold architecture, such as the arched Market Hall. Admire the cityscape on a guided walk, and visit one of the quirky Cube Houses. On a scenic tour, see the sleek Erasmus Bridge and the non-stop activity of the huge harbor.

A Visit to Noord-Holland. Delight in the picturesque harbor town, Hoorn, once a key Dutch East India Company port. Then take a ride on an antique steam train before visiting the engineering marvel, Afsluitdijk, a 20-mile dike that separates the North Sea and Ijssel Lake. Finally, stroll through lovely Bergen, a longtime artists' community, dotted with thatched-roof homes and art galleries.

**Amsterdam.** Arrive by high-speed rail and enjoy a canal cruise past the city's iconic gabled houses. The rest of the day is yours to plan! Dine by the sea tonight in Zandvoort.

Hoge Veluwe National Park and the Kröller-Müller Museum. Revel in this vast park's serene, natural beauty en route to the museum, which boasts the second largest van Gogh collection in the world and a large sculpture garden.

#### Royal Flora Holland and The Hague.

Watch impressive logistics in action in Royal Flora's auction facility in Aalsmeer as colorful blooms are briskly traded and whisked off for shipping. Each day, 30 million flowers and plants are sold on its trading platform. Then travel to The Hague and walk with your guide past elegant governmental and royal landmarks, including the Peace Palace and the Binnenhof. End at the Mauritshuis to see superb art by Dutch and Flemish masters.

**St.-Bavo Church.** Hear the rich sounds of the church's ornate Müller barrel organ, built in 1738, during a short performance.
