Discovery

AHI Connects: Field to Fork Dining.

Tour the Longueville House grounds with the owners and learn how they revitalized their 500-acre estate. Later, savor a special dinner prepared by the chef-owner with fresh ingredients from the farm and gardens.

Ennis Tour. Explore the history and folklore of County Clare's capital city on a walk.

The Burren and Cliffs of Moher. Take a fascinating walk over the Burren's striking landscape of karstic limestone formations with local expert Tony Kirby, who will share geological and botanical insights. Next, delve into the Irish field game of hurling, played for thousands of years, at a museum dedicated to the Gaelic Athletic Association. After a stop to see the iconic Poulnabrone dolmen, delight in the stunning Wild Atlantic Way as you head along the coast to take in the Cliffs of Moher rising dramatically over the ocean.

In the Footsteps of Yeats. William Butler Yeats, the acclaimed Nobel poet laureate, found inspiration in the beautiful woods of Coole Park and 14th-century Thoor Ballylee, his summer retreat where he wrote many of his works. Learn about Yeats and other famed literary figures as you visit both sites.

Loop Head Peninsula. Incredible scenery surrounds you as you travel to the tip of this headland that juts out between the Atlantic Ocean and the Shannon Estuary. Relax over lunch, then tour the Loop Head Lighthouse.

Birr Castle Gardens & Science Center.

From 1845-1914, this 400-year-old castle possessed the world's largest telescope, credited with significant discoveries. View the telescope and other scientific innovations made here, and admire the rare plants and magnificent trees in the elegant gardens. Break for lunch in Killaloe before cruising on lovely Lough Derg and the River Shannon.

Aran Island of Inishmore. Ferry across Galway Bay to this starkly beautiful locale where people have lived since the Stone Age. Meet a family who hand-harvests edible seaweed, an often-forgotten ancient food source, and try some samples as you hear about their business. Then, journey to see the Bronze Age fort ruins of Dun Aengus.

Music in Doolin. Revel in warm hospitality, wonderful music and great stories at a private home in this very musical village.

Adare Manor. A three-course artisanal lunch and garden stroll are in store at this stately manor, now a luxury hotel and resort.

Rock of Cashel. Once the seat of the kings of Munster, this impressive site on a limestone outcrop later became an important medieval religious center. On a guided walk, appreciate the remarkable church ruins.
