

Your Itinerary

DAY ONE

Arrival Day - Check into Hotel Commonwealth, meet SET staff, & pick up on-site travel documents. In the early evening, enjoy a Welcome Reception, featuring dinner & "Baseball 101" discussion with Dr. Michael Raycraft.

DAY TWO

Following a private group breakfast, the group will walk to Fenway Park for a private tour of one of baseball's most historic ballparks. Then the group will see the greatest rivalries in sports as the Red Sox take on the New York Yankees. Remainder of the day will allow for exploration of Boston.

DAY THREE After a private group breakfast, we will take a scenic bus ride that will lead the group to Historic Cooperstown, along with a brief stop in Stockbridge, Massachusetts for lunch at the Red Lion Inn. After checking into the Otesaga Resort, kick back and relax before a group dinner along with a brief discussion on Cooperstown's significance to baseball and the Hall of Fame.

DAY FOUR National Baseball Hall of Fame Day! Following breakfast, the group will be welcomed by Hall of Fame staff and taken for a private Artifact Spotlight for an up close experience of historic baseball items. Afterwards, the group will tour the Hall of Fame. The afternoon and evening will be at leisure to explore all Cooperstown has to offer.

An early morning departure starts the day with a scenic bus ride from Cooperstown to New York City. The day will feature a tour of Yankee Stadium. New York Yankees vs. Baltimore Orioles game, & tour farewell event to recap the week's events!
