Discovery

AHI Connects: Glen Keen Farm.

Watch steely-eyed border collies maneuver a flock of sheep at a family-owned farm. Learn about farm life with a member of the family.

Dublin. Become acquainted with the lively Irish capital during a panoramic tour, then visit historic Trinity College and see the famous hand-illuminated Book of Kells, created by monks in the eighth century.

Westport. Take a short walking tour of Westport, a charming Georgian town along Ireland's scenic northwest coast.

Galway and Cong. On a guided walk, get to know spirited Galway, brimming with live music and street performers. Enjoy free time to wander through Cong, the charming village featured in the 1952 John Wayne classic, "The Quiet Man."

Achill Island. Witness the untamed beauty of Achill Island. Visit the Deserted Village at Slievemore. Learn how to make Irish coffee and enjoy a cup with a view of Clew Bay.

Connemara. Visit the National Famine Monument at the foot of Croagh Patrick Mountain. Appreciate the stark beauty of the Connemara region as you make your way to Kylemore Abbey. Learn about the love story behind the 19th-century castle.

County Sligo. In "Yeats' Country," visit the famed poet's grave. Enjoy free time in Donegal Town before visiting the Sliabh Liag, or Slieve League, dramatic sea cliffs that tower nearly 2,000 feet above the Atlantic Ocean. Take a guided cliffside walk.

Glenveagh Castle and a Taste of **Donegal.** Tour Glenveagh Castle, a stately 19th-century estate. Travel Donegal's scenic countryside and visit some of the county's specialty food purveyors to taste the flavors of Donegal's culinary culture.

Arranmore Sea Safari. Take a boat tour of coastal Donegal to see the fishing villages and historic landmarks that tell the story of the county's long relationship with the sea.

Leo's Tavern. Step inside the renowned tavern owned by the family of music artists Enya, Clannad and Moya Brennan. Enjoy an Irish coffee and some music.

Dungloe. Take a walking tour of the pretty town of Dungloe.

Derry and Giant's Causeway. See the highlights of Derry, surrounded by 17thcentury city walls. Learn about the legend of Finn McCool and marvel at the hexagonal basalt columns of Giant's Causeway.

Castle Leslie. Learn about the history of the family-owned castle during a tour.
