Exchange. Participate in an expansive discussion with a scholar, where no question is off limits and dialogue is encouraged, and share a traditional Emirati meal afterward.

House. Enjoy the hospitality and fellowship of a homemade meal in an Emirati home.

Traditional Dubai. Dubai began as a fishing village and later thrived due to its pearl diving industry. Examine this rich history at the Al Shindagha Museum and take a guided walk in the Al Fahidi Historic Neighborhood, known for its well-preserved merchant homes featuring wind towers, an ancient ventilation method. Cross Dubai Creek on an abra water taxi and meander through the colorful Spice and Gold Souks.

Modern Dubai. Take in spectacular views from the skydeck of the iconic Dubai Frame in Zabeel Park. Next, see the grand Zabeel Palace and the Jumeirah Mosque, then visit the man-made archipelago, Palm Jumeirah. After lunch in Dubai Marina, spend time at the Dubai Mall, renowned for its retail shops and the Dubai Aquarium and Underwater Zoo. Gaze upward at nearby Burj Khalifa, the world's tallest building!

Dubai Desert Conservation Reserve.

In the Arabian Desert, take an easy drive through this protected desert habitat to discover fascinating flora and fauna. Later, at the hotel, take a thrilling drive over the dunes in a 4X4 desert vehicle. (Active)

Arabian Nights. Enjoy traditional food and live entertainment under starry desert skies.

Desert Oasis. Visit Al Jahidi Fort, one of the UAE's largest forts, before touring the Al Ain Palace Museum, the former home of the nation's founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan. Then enjoy lunch and a stroll amid the beautiful, lush Al Ain Oasis.

Abu Dhabi Falcon Hospital & Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque. Learn about the falcon, the UAE's national bird, at a hospital devoted to these majestic creatures. Later, tour one of the world's largest mosques with room for 55,000 worshippers, which welcomes people of all faiths. Marvel at the breathtaking marble courtyard, columns inlaid with amethyst and jasper, reflective pools and more on a guided tour.

Abu Dhabi. Relish picturesque gulf views and see well-known landmarks including the Emirates Palace, Etihad Towers and the lovely Corniche waterfront. Next, tour the Qasr al Watan, the UAE's impressive, modern presidential palace, magnificently decorated in homage to traditional Arabian artistry. Afterward, visit Qasr al Hosn, the city's oldest heritage site.
